Minutes for Gold Coast Woodturners meeting –October 18, 2007

Jerry Remillard, our president, called our meeting to order at 7:00. As usual, he recommended that members join the AAW for the benefits of their insurance, quarterly magazine, member's directory and symposiums.

We have two new members this month. Welcome, and we look forward to sharing our experience in turning.

It's election time again.

In November we will be electing new officers for our club. Jerry asked if anyone wanted to volunteer for various offices. We can also take offers again at our next meeting and we will also be voting during the November meeting. Ed McDonald's name has been offered for president.

We immediately started the meeting with **Gerhard Schwenke** demonstration of making threads. Gerhard apologized in advance as he said that it is a boring but very valuable adjunct to turning. He showed various applications of where threading is helpful. He occasionally uses threaded blanks to attach directly to the threads on a lathe, eliminating the need for a chuck. He also can attach a contrasting collar to a piece with threads which eliminated the need for glue.

Gerhard gave some time saving tips: mark the jaws of your chuck so you won't have to guess when replacing items. And PLAN for the wood grain to match before cutting the threads. Gerhard had many cutters for various threads per inch, TPI, from 6 tpi to 32tpi. The higher number is best used on small pieces. He suggested using a slow speed when thread chasing. It requires practice and his recommendation was to start with dense wood like boxwood or cocobolo.

Thanks, Gerhard for sharing your skill and knowledge.

Following his excellent demonstration we had a short break while some of our members quickly shopped.

Ron Purcell spoke briefly about the Georgia symposium and had photos to show the beautiful works that were exhibited. He then gave his treasurer's report saying we have \$920 in the treasury which doesn't include \$51.00 from our wood raffle or the dues from our new members and \$300 for the show

Rick Pixley, our show chairman, reminded us of the juried show that we will be participating in this weekend **at Young Circle in Hollywood**. We have 8 or 9 members who will be selling and demonstrating who have shared the entry cost of \$300. Ten percent of the profit will be given to the club. . .

Please make some ornaments for our tree that will be auctioned in mid November. The ornaments should be taken to WoodCraft or to Lee Sky by the 14th or November. It's lots of fun decorating our tree that is part of the **Festival of Trees** at the Galleria Mall on Sunrise Blvd. Call Lee for all information.
